



Light paint colours on both the exterior and interior of the Landmark Homes Karaka house keep the look fresh and lively.

making it easier to clean than a lower sheen finish and easier on the eye than a high gloss finish. It's also available in Resene CoolColour technology when darker colours are planned.

Resene SpaceCote Low Sheen and Resene Zylone Sheen are recommended for interior broadwalls. These are also waterborne paints that are low-odour and Environmental Choice-approved. They are durable and easy to wipe down, so well suited to family homes.
