This spacious home offers generous living spaces and great indoor-outdoor flow – the exteriors and interiors are finished in crisp Resene colours

The main walls are in Resene Double White Pointer throughout – a warmed up neutral tending towards beige. The doors,

door frames, architraves and skirtings are also in Resene Alabaster, while the ceilings are in Resene Double Alabaster.
