+ The beauty of timber can bring the outdoors in and create a lovely warm feeling in a room. To keep the timber looking good it needs to be well protected.

+ Use Resene 'AquaClear' on wooden walls and cabinetry or opt for Resene 'Orystal ClearFloor' on timber flooring. Both are non-yellowing and have a very low odour compared with traditional solvent-borne polyurethanes.

MIX COLOURS FOR A PLAYFUL LOOK
