


+ Painted stripes are a brilliant way to add interest to your walls. Often wallpaper stripes won't be available in the colours you want, so if you paint on your own stripes you can choose your favourite Resene shades and decide how thick or thin you want the stripes to be. + Make sure you use low tack masking tape to mask off the stripe areas, and remove the tape before the paint dries.
