

## Lavender room freshener



**Difficulty level** ★easy ★★moderate ★★★challenging

## You will need:

- Clean damp cloth
- Glass jar
- Lavender
- Paintbrushes
- Secateurs

 Resene testpots in your choice of colours, Mark used Resene Half Alabaster, Resene Japonica, Resene Kamikaze, Resene Sebedee and Resene Wax Flower



**Step 1** Clean the glass jar with a damp cloth and allow to dry.



**Step 2**Apply random spots of Resene Sebedee to the inside of the jar and allow to dry.



**Step 3**Apply random spots of Resene Kamikaze to the inside of the jar and allow to dry.



Step 4
Apply random spots of Resene Japonica to the inside of the jar and allow to dry.



Step 5
Apply smaller random spots of Resene Wax Flower to the inside of the jar and allow to dry.

In Australia:



Step 6
Paint the inside of the jar with one coat of Resene Half Alabaster and allow to dry.



Step 7
Paint the inside of the jar with a second coat of Resene Half Alabaster and allow to dry.



Step 8
Clip a woody sprig of lavender and place inside the jar.

It's easy to create this simple room freshener with a little bit of help from Resene.



To get the look: Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Flat tinted to Resene China Ivory.
