You will need:

- Clean damp cloth
- Old photo canvas
- Paint stirrer
- Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Black
- Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Wellywood
- Resene Quick Dry
- Resene testpot brush
- Small roller and tray



Step 1 Clean the photo canvas with a clean damp cloth and allow to dry.



Step 2 Carefully stir the Resene Quick Dry.



Step 3 Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry to the photo canvas using a small roller and allow to dry.



Step 4 Carefully stir the Resene Enamacryl tinted Resene Wellywood.



Step 5 Apply one coat of Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Wellywood to the primed canvas using a small roller and allow to dry.



Step 6 Apply a second coat of Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Wellywood to the canvas using a small roller and allow to dry.



Step 7 Carefully stir the Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Black.



Step 8 Using a Resene testpot Resene brush, drip Enamacryl tinted to Resene Black over the canvas in a random pattern and allow to dry.

Transform an old photo canvas into an abstract masterpiece with a little bit of help from Resene.



To get the look: Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Flat tinted to Resene Black White.



Other ideas: For a vibrant red effect use Resene Chaos as the background colour.
