Difficulty level ★easy ★★moderate ★★★challenging

Resene art with Mark Rayner - 74

You will need:

- Damp sponge
- Paintbrush
- Plastic picture frame
- Resene Aquaclear gloss
- Resene Smooth Surface Sealer
- Resene testpots of Resene Allusive and Resene Gull Grey
- Sandpaper
- Small wooden stirrer



Step oneRemove the glass and backing from the picture frame.



Step twoLightly sand the plastic frame to 'key' the surface.



Step threeWipe off any sanding residue with a damp sponge.



Step four
Apply one coat of Resene
Smooth Surface Sealer to
the frame and allow two
hours to dry.



Apply one coat of Resene Gull Grey to the frame and allow two hours to dry.



Step sixCarefully stir the testpot of Resene Allusive.



Step seven
Apply two coats of Resene
Allusive to the frame,
allowing two hours for
each coat to dry.



Step eightApply two coats of Resene
Aquaclear gloss to the
frame, allowing two hours
for each coat to dry.

Transform a humble plastic picture frame into a stylish retro feature with a little bit of help from Resene.



To get the look:

Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Flat tinted to Resene Agua.



Other ideas:

For a rich gold effect paint the frame with one coat of Resene Porsche and two coats of Resene Bullion.
