# **Fluoro flowerpot**

It's easy to create this dazzling plant pot using two fabulous Resene FX Fluoro colours.

You will need:

• Resene Testpot brush

Resene Terracotta Sealer

• Resene FX Fluoro Orange

• Artists' brush

#### Step one

Apply one coat of Resene Terracotta Sealer to the entire inside and outside of the plant pot and allow to dry.

#### Step two

Apply two coats of Resene White to the outside and inner rim of the plant pot. Allow two hours for each coat to dry.



#### Step three

Paint stripes on the outside and inner rim of the plant pot, as show, using Resene FX Fluoro Yellow. Once the first coat has dried, apply a second coat and allow to dry.



### Step four

Paint stripes on the outside of the plant pot, as show, using Resene FX Fluoro Orange. Again, once the first coat has dried, apply a second coat and allow to dry. How cool is that?

**Top tip:** For a shiny finish apply two coats of Resene Art Action Glaze (gloss) to the outside of the plant pot.
