## You will need:

- Hard cover exercise book
- Paintbrushes (including an artists' brush)
- Resene Crackle Effect
- Resene Multishield+ gloss
- Resene Quick Dry waterborne primer undercoat
- Resene Testpots of Resene Pulse, Resene Resolution Blue and Resene Rubber Duck



#### Step one

Paint the front and back covers of the exercise book with one coat of Resene Quick Dry and allow two hours to dry.



#### Step two

Paint the front and back covers of the exercise book with two coats of Resene Rubber Duck, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.




#### Step three

Apply one coat of Resene Crackle Effect to the front and back covers of the exercise book and allow to dry.



#### **Step four**

Paint the front and back covers of the exercise book with one coat of Resene Resolution Blue and allow two hours to dry.



#### **Step five**

Using an artists' brush and Resene Pulse, paint the words 'My Secret Diary' on the front cover of the exercise book.



#### Step six


Apply one coat of Resene Multishield+ gloss to the front and back covers of the exercise book and allow two hours to dry. How cool is that?





# Top tip:

If you want to decorate a soft cover exercise book in the same way, glue two pieces of stiff cardboard to the front and back covers and allow the glue to dry before painting.
