## You will need:

- Paintbrush
- Resene Art Action Quick Dry
- Resene Testpots in the following colours: Resene Astronaut and Resene Super Sonic
- Self-hardening clay

#### Step one

Mould a small bowl from self-hardening clay, as shown, and allow to dry.



#### Step two

Apply one coat of Resene Art Action Quick Dry to the bowl and allow to dry for two hours.



#### Step three

Apply one coat of Resene Astronaut to the bowl and allow to dry for two hours.



#### Step four

Apply two coats of Resene Super Sonic to the bowl, allowing two hours for each coat to dry. How cool is that?

Create this cool metallic effect bowl from self-hardening clay and a couple of Resene Testpots.





# Top tip:

To help the clay dry quicker leave the bowl in an airing cupboard overnight or stand it outside in the sun.



## **Here's another idea:**

This groovy green bowl was painted with a base coat of Resene Anise and two topcoats of Resene Go Go.
