You will need:

- Clean cloth
- Kitset canvas deckchair (ours came from Mitre 10 Mega)
- Paintbrush

- Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Bright Red
- Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer
- Sandpaper
- Screwdriver



Step one Remove the kitset deckchair from the packaging.



Step two Carefully take off the protective cardboard covers from the deckchair



Step three Unscrew the plastic leg brackets, as shown, and put to one side.



Step four Lightly sand the entire deckchair frame to provide a 'key'. Wipe off any sanding dust with a clean cloth.

Step five Apply one coat of Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer to the deckchair frame and allow two hours to dry.



Step six Apply two coats of Resene Bright Red to the deckchair frame, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step seven Screw the plastic leg brackets back into position, as shown.



Step eight Following manufacturer's instructions, thread the canvas seat into position on the deckchair frame, fixing in place with the dowel provided.
