### You will need:

- Decking nails
- Hammer
- Old wooden work bench
- Paint stirrer
- Paintbrushes
- Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Green House
- Resene Wood Primer
- Turps for cleaning paintbrush



**Step 1**  
Clean the work bench thoroughly and fix any loose pieces of wood with decking nails.



**Step 2**  
Carefully stir the Resene Wood Primer.



**Step 3**  
Turn the bench upside down and apply one coat of Resene Wood Primer to the underside.



**Step 4**  
Turn the bench the right way up and apply one coat of Resene Wood Primer to the top, sides and legs and then allow to dry. Clean brush in turps.



**Step 5**  
Carefully stir the Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Green House.



**Step 6**  
Turn the bench upside down and apply one coat of Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Green House to the underside.



**Step 7**  
Turn the bench the right way up and apply one coat of Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Green House to the top, sides and legs. Allow two hours to dry.



**Step 8**  
Apply a second coat of Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Green House to the bench and allow two hours to dry.

It's easy to revamp an old wooden work bench with a little bit of help from Resene.



**To get the look:**  
Mark painted the watering can with Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Spritzer.



**Other ideas:**  
For a rich brown effect paint the bench with Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Brown Pod.
