Step two Soak the gate with the solution and leave for 48 hours.



Step three Mix one part Resene Timber and Deck Wash to three parts clean water.

Step five Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow gate to dry.



Step six Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry to the gate and allow two hours to dry.
