Preparation

Ensure surfaces to be coated are in sound condition, dry, free from dirt, dust, loose material, oil and grease.
If mould is present, treat with Resene Moss & Mould Killer (see Data Sheet D80).

• Stop all nail holes and cracked timber with a suitable filler.

• Thoroughly sand surfaces prior to coating. Finish off with fine sandpaper, remembering always to sand with the grain.
