

STEP 3 Apply two coats of Resene Brandy Punch to the walls, allowing two hours to dry between coats.



STEP 5 Stamp on 'pink icing sugar cookies' over the rest of the walls using Resene Illusion.

STEP 6 Once dry, create 'jam fillings' using a small brush and Resene Bright Red.





with Resene Waterborne Aquapel (otherwise the paint will bubble off). Once dry, apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry primer undercoat to the outside and inner rim of the pot.



STEP 2 Apply two coats of Resene Wild Thing (test pot) to the outside and inner rim of the pot, allowing two hours to dry between coats.



STEP 3 Now the pot is prepared, let your child help decorate it. Using Resene testpots, paint a large head and neck with Resene Picton Blue and a shirt with Resene Kingfisher Daisy. Once dry, fill in the nose and mouth with Resene Black and teeth with Resene Alabaster.



STEP 4 Paint the whole pot with one coat of Resene Multishield+ Gloss. Once dry, glue on some eyes with PVA glue.

STEP 5 Cut and unravel some short lengths of green garden twine and stick into place to create hair using Multishield+ Gloss. Allow to dry.
